- A. A suggestion was made that we have a representative from District 6 come and discuss the American Development Model prior to the end of the current hockey season, so there is a better understanding of how the model will work
- B. Two representatives from the Shoreline program came to express a concern regarding the number of kids on the ice during cross-ice. Currently there are 10 kids to 1 coach for the 6 scheduled stations and cross-ice is currently broken down for 2 levels. Could it possibly be broken down to 3 levels, as it has in the past, for 2010?
- C. Sign-up's for the 2010-11 hockey season will begin in April. We will need coaches to start evaluating kids in order to make recommendations for next year by the end of the season.
